Secretary of State Kobach Awards NASS Medallion

TOPEKA (August 19, 2011) –This afternoon Secretary of State Kris Kobach presented a NASS Medallion award in the Dean’s Office at Fort Hays State University, Hays, Kansas.

Sue Boldra received the award for her decades of commitment to teaching history and government at the high school and university level. As state coordinator for *We the People ... The Citizen and the Constitution*, she has taken several teams of students to Washington, D.C. to compete in the national finals of simulated congressional hearings.

“Our country has a significant deficit in civics education among our youth. Sue Boldra has done a great deal to solve that problem, through her leadership of *We the People*,” said Kobach. “She is a great Kansan and a worthy recipient of this award.”
