### **STATE OBJECTIONS BOARD TO RECONVENE**

TOPEKA (September 14, 2012) – The Secretary of State will reconvene a meeting of the State Objections Board on Monday, September 17, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Secretary of State's office, Memorial Hall, 120 SW 10th Avenue, Second Floor, Topeka, Kansas.

The board will meet to review the following:

- 1) Objection filed by Joe Montgomery to the eligibility of Barack Obama for President of the United States as nominated by the Democratic Party;
- 2) Withdrawal of objection filed by Joe Montgomery to the eligibility of Barack Obama for President of the United States as nominated by the Democratic Party.
